Cassette to MP3 Converter, Quick Guide

Offers three power source options:

Battery, USB to Computer, or USB to wall outlet (USB AC adapter not provided.)

Offers two file storage options:

USB flash drive (not provided, but can be purchased at main desk if needed.)

USB Reader with SD Card (not provided.)

Completed recordings can be played on the converter using the controls on the backside of device.

Getting Started:

If not using batteries to power converter, plug into USB charging device first.

- 1. Insert cassette with first side to be recorded, face up.
 - (Open cover by sliding open bar down.)
- 2. Insert device you will be saving the recording to (USB flash drive or reader.)
- 3. Turn over converter to access recording button, select record prior to pressing play (if no lead time before what you would like to record.)
- 4. Use headphones to follow along with what is actively being recorded.

Finishing up:

- 5. When done recording press stop on outside of converter to stop playing the cassette tape, then press record button a second time to stop.
- 6. If all done, rewind your cassette to return to beginning for future play.

 The recording is complete, if desired, insert USB device with new recording into computer to save separately or share.
